Course Courtesy and Guidelines for Members

We ask that members check in with the ProShop and commence play on Hole No. 1.

On the other hand, we realize that some members like to commence play on a hole adjacent to their home - please use common sense and as a courtesy to the ProShop, phone to advise staff of your intentions. We ask that members do not jump in front of other golfers. The ProShop needs to know that the players on the course are legitimate; additionally, number of rounds played is reported to the National Golf Foundation. Your cooperation is appreciated.

In the past we have had issues with people golfing before or after hours; this is not allowed.

Private golf carts can only be used on the course with a season trail pass sticker. Contact the ProShop to purchase a season trail pass (\$300 for members).

Underage children are not permitted to drive a MeadowCreek golf cart (driver license is required to operate a golf cart).

It would be appreciated if members communicate these guidelines to your family and guests.

The **WORLD HANDICAP SYSTEM** is a modern handicap system for all golfers everywhere. The WHS was launched beginning January 2020 and provides golfers with a unified and more inclusive handicapping system for the first time.

Though many countries are planning to adopt the new system in January, the system will go live in other parts of the world throughout the year to accommodate different implementation plans and variations in the golfing calendar.

Developed by The R&A and USGA in close coordination with existing handicapping authorities, the WHS will provide all golfers with a consistent measure of playing ability, with handicaps calculated in the same way wherever they are in the world. A key objective of the initiative was to develop a modern system, enabling as many golfers as possible to obtain and maintain a Handicap Index. Golfers will be able to transport their Handicap Index globally and compete or play a casual round with players from other regions on a fair basis. It will also indicate the score a golfer is reasonably capable of achieving the next time they go out to play.
